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## Summary of Action on Mission Goals

2015 marks sixteen years of good work done by the Wound Healing Foundation (WHF) to achieve its mission of improving the quality of life for wound healing patients and their families through support of awareness, research and education. Since its inception, WHF has raised over **\$320k** in grants and scholarships for wound healing research, education and awareness. In the last three years alone, over **\$160k** in wound care products have been specifically donated in support of Wounded Warrior Athletes. Such an achievement could not have been reached without the tireless efforts of our private and corporate donors, the dedicated wound care community, and the WHF Board of Directors. Below are a few noteworthy milestones qualifying 2015 as **a good year to heal wounds**.

- Wound Healing Foundation (WHF) underwent clarifying name change yielding new branding, image, and a new website!
- Over 3,400 WHF volunteer hours were dedicated to raising funds for wound healing research, education and disease state awareness
- Wound Healing Foundation's Thomas K Hunt Endowed Lecture brought innovative thought leader, Leroy Hood, MD, PhD, to the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Wound Healing Society meeting
- First time in WHF history, expanded outreach and opportunity to international members enabling eligibility for funding
- WHF benefitted from an expanded presence and awareness at international meetings and events as well as on social media platforms reaching a larger cross-section of supporters
- Expanded strategic alliance base with multiple partnerships with individual donors, caregivers and patients; corporate sponsors; small businesses; other foundations; and media outlets to enhance awareness, research and education in the wound healing community.
